



## **Pool Rules and Regulations**

1. All children age 12 or under, must be accompanied by parent, legal guardian, or responsible person assigned by letter to club, from parent or legal guardian.
2. No floats allowed except those used as flotation devices (arm wings, baby floats and those used during adult swim. Note: The so-called "swimmies" or tubes and other non-approved devices have proven to be unreliable and dangerous. Use of such flotation devices does not relieve the parent, legal guardian, or responsible person of a child who is unable to swim from responsibility for supervising and being in the pool with such child.
3. Neither food nor beverages shall be brought onto pool premises for consumption, as it is required that all food and beverages consumed be purchased from the pool cabana. Anyone requiring an exception to this rule for medical or other compelling reasons must obtain such an exception in advance by the Pool Manager.
4. DO NOT leave your car running at the front gate unattended. This is a policed "no parking" area and will not be allowed.
5. No running or rough play permitted at any time.
6. Only one person on the diving board ladder at a time.
7. No swimming in diving area unless approved by guard and boards are closed.
8. Diving allowed only when clear in front. One bounce and straight off board.
9. No swimming permitted except during scheduled hours.
10. Persons with open cuts, bandaged skin areas or infectious diseases, whether skin or respiratory, are not permitted in the swimming pool at any time.
11. No flotation devices in diving area.
12. Due to manufacturers weight specifications, weight limit for individual using diving board is 250 lbs.
13. Dogs or other pets are not allowed within the pool enclosure.
14. Persons in bathing attire, beach robes, etc., are not permitted in the clubhouse.

15. No food or drink is allowed in the swimming pool. (Chewing gum included.)
16. No cut-offs pants of any type will be allowed in the pool.
17. Playing on the lifelines (ropes) are not permitted.
18. Children must mind lifeguards on duty or be suspended. The Pool Manager is in charge of the pool at all times. In his/her absence the Assistant Manager will be in charge.
19. During swim meets, no swimming allowed in intermediate pool or wading pool.
20. Pool parties may be scheduled with the approval of the General Manager. Club sponsored parties may be held at other times with Pool Committee approval.
21. Adult swimmers shall always have priority in the lap pool.
22. No alcoholic beverages shall be allowed in the pool area.
23. No throwing or pushing of anyone into the pools.
24. All pool users should take a shower and be wet before entering the pool.
25. Diving into the pools is not permitted, except for the designated diving well.
26. The club assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to personal property or for injury to persons, either members or guests, suffered as a result of utilization of swimming pool facilities.
27. Membership cards must be turned in at the gate in order to enter. The member must sign in their guests.
28. You are not allowed to move lodge chairs from there designated area.
29. Please do not talk to lifeguards while on stand or at poolside.
30. Guest fees are \$5.00 daily per person. Baby sitters for members' children must be approved in advance with management.
31. Children (5 years and younger) are allowed in "wading pool area" and must be supervised by an adult. Also children in the wading pool must be under adult supervision at all times.
32. Leak-proof swimsuits (diapers) are required for all children that are not potty trained.
33. Shelters are for picnic use only.
34. Lounging in the red marked "restricted areas" is prohibited.

35. No hard balls, small balls, water guns, pistols, balloons, straight diving sticks are allowed. Rings are approved.
36. Showers close at 7:45PM for cleaning.
37. There will be an "under 18" rest break every hour for 15 minutes.
38. The pool must be cleared immediately if you hear the "emergency" signal (three whistle blasts).
39. No roller blading, skateboarding, or bike riding on parking lot.
40. Please keep our parking area as well as our pool area, clean and litter free.
41. Please advise guards immediately of any unsafe or unhealthy conditions that exist in the pool, restrooms or parking areas.
42. Please remember that the pool is for the enjoyment of all members, and courtesy and consideration of each other's rights will lead to everyone's enjoyment.
43. Our pool is a smoke-free pool. We do have one designated smoking area. We enforce the under-age smoking laws.
