



These regulations are established to familiarize members with the rules governing Tennis play so as to insure a smooth operation and give equal opportunity for member participation.

Day to day operation of the Tennis program has been entrusted to the Golf Staff under the direction of the Board of Directors.

Problems, complaints or infractions that cannot be handled by the Golf Staff should be referred to the General Manager.

A. General

1. The Board of Directors shall make, adopt, and administer all rules and regulations relating to play and use of the tennis courts. Regulations may be amended from time to time at the discretion of the Board. Violations of any of the Tennis Regulations by a member, spouse, family member or guest, may result in a reprimand, or fine being assessed against the member by the Board. Any such reprimand or fine shall be in the sole discretion of the Board of Directors. In no event shall the fine be greater than \$75.00 for the first offense and \$100.00 for the second offense. Nothing herein contained shall prohibit the Board of Directors from issuing any additional sanctions as permitted by the by-laws.
2. Reservations for play are provided as a service to the membership throughout the year. They are not required but are suggested. If members wish to reserve a court, they may do so up to one week in advance by calling the Golf Shop at 992-4653. Members must call to cancel reservations that will not be used and failure to comply may result in a reprimand from the Board of Directors. The Board may reserve "court time" for the overall benefit of the tennis program. NOTE: A court reservation will only be held for fifteen (15) minutes past your reserved time. At that time, your court can be subject to forfeiture. In order to guarantee your reservation, you must notify the Golf Shop in the event you will be arriving late.
3. Regulation tennis shoes must be worn by all players. Running shoes are not allowed.
4. Use of the tennis facility is strictly for members of Ashley Plantation Country Club and for members of the Swim Club that have elected to add Tennis privileges to their Swim Club membership at an additional charge.
5. Members may invite guests (singles or doubles) at no charge. Guests must play with a member. The same in-town guest may not be invited more than twice a month.
6. Proper tennis attire must be worn at all times. Tank tops, cut-off jeans, leotards, or bathing suits are not acceptable attire. All players must wear shirts.
7. Players may appear on reservation sheet only once at any time. Another reservation for the same day is allowed after completion of playing time.
8. Individuals may not use court alone if two or more persons are waiting to play.

9. **Members must register court times and all guests by signing the Member Book in the Golf Shop prior to play.**
10. **Court courtesy is expected at all times. Foul language, racquet slamming or disruption of other's games will not be permitted.**
11. **Playing time is one and one-half (1 & ½) hours for singles and for doubles when other players are waiting.**
12. **Junior members (dependants) may reserve courts for one hour (singles or doubles) and as much as one day in advance.**
