

Ashley Plantation Country Club Pool Facility Rules

The pool is a private facility for the use and enjoyment of members, therefore, anyone entering the pool area must be a Club Member or invited guest and must register at the main gate (A lifeguard will be on duty to assist).

We ask your cooperation with the following rules to help ensure that all members may enjoy their time at the pool.

Guest policy: Guests must be accompanied by the sponsoring member. The guest fee must be paid at the time entering. The sponsoring member is responsible for the conduct and finances of the guest as well as registering the guest. A local guest may use the pool no more than once a month during the pool season. Fees for local and outside guests are \$5.00.

A parent or parent-authorized person of at least 15 years old who swims must accompany any child age 9 or under. Babysitters must be registered. Any child 10 - 15 years old may register unaccompanied only under the following conditions.

An official waiver form (obtained from the pool staff) signed by the parent(s) and presented at the gate upon the child's first day at the pool including emergency contacts.

To qualify for the waiver the child must have passed a swim test administered by an APCC Lifeguard. The waiver grants the lifeguard the authority to take corrective action with the child if necessary, and may be revoked by Staff at any time. (Parental waiver form is attached)

Parents are ultimately responsible for the behavior and supervision of their minor children. At the discretion of the lifeguard, penalties (ejection from the facility and/or suspension of privileges) may be imposed on anyone judged to be engaging in horseplay, roughhousing, running or any other disruptive or undesirable behavior.

1st Offense - Warning 2nd Offense - 15 minutes of sitting out of the pool 3rd Offense - Suspension of pool privileges for the day and notification of parents 4th Offense (habitual offender) - Suspension of pool privileges.

Problems or concerns should be brought to the attention of a lifeguard or the pool manager.

No one except the lifeguards are allowed on the lifeguard's chair. Patrons are not to distract lifeguards on duty.

Persons judged by APCC Staff to be non-swimmers must remain at the shallow end of the pool. To pass a swim test for the deep end, lifeguards will ask you to swim 25 yards and tread in water for 30 seconds. Please see the lifeguard at the front desk.

Adults are not permitted to catch children jumping off the diving board.

In keeping with no running policy, swimmers are allowed only two steps before entering the water.

The kiddy pool is for children aged 5 and under only. This pool is not always supervised by a lifeguard. Parents are responsible for their children. Toys and playthings are permitted only in the kiddy pool.

The lifeguard will clear the pool of children under the age of 16 for 10 minutes prior to every hour between

2:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. (Lifeguard discretion) for adult lap swim.

Please refrain from bring any food and beverage to the facility, the exception being infant food and formula.

Alcohol is allowed ONLY if purchased from the club in accordance with VABC law.

Lounge chairs are reserved first for use by adults. Adults may request that children under 16 surrender their lounges if there are no more available. Only one chair per person.

Appropriate swimsuits are required in the pool. No cut-offs, shorts, or boxers are allowed.

Members and guests are expected to help maintain orderliness in the bath house. The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen articles and anything left at the pool more than 14 days will be disposed of.

A lap lane is roped off except during periods determined by the lifeguard as congested. This lane is for the exclusive use of serious swimmers, with no age limits.

We ask that swimmers not enter the clubhouse in bathing suits. Cover ups are required.
